Our previous charity car shows were held in downtown Chandler, Arizona and were exclusively for Corvettes and Chevrolet vehicles. This year, we are now expanding our car show to include all makes of domestic American made automobiles. We have moved our venue to the Martin Auto Museum. We are expecting a large number of cars and participants. Space is limited at the museum, so there is limited registration to the first 150 cars! We are encouraging early registration to guarantee your spot at the charity car show! Our previous shows have always had a great turn out.
